

Re: Required Documentation for Secondary Exposure Claims – Fuller-Austin Asbestos Settlement Trust

The Trust has implemented an audit process for secondary exposure claims other than Mesothelioma claims. To ensure that secondary exposure claims can be reviewed and processed without delay, we are informing you that the Fuller-Austin Asbestos Settlement Trust will now require the following documentation to be submitted when filing secondary exposure claims other than Mesothelioma claims.

1. B-read reports
2. Deposition transcripts
3. All other medical documents relevant to the diagnosis of an asbestos-related condition
4. All medical history and diagnoses of interstitial lung disease that can cause parenchymal changes in the lungs other than an asbestos related condition, such as pneumonia
5. Any other non-privileged documentation describing the injured party's exposure to asbestos, including documentation of the injured party's direct occupational exposure to asbestos, if any
6. A signed Secondary Exposure Documentation Certificate

CT scan reports may also be provided, if available, as such reports may expedite the review of secondary exposure claims.

Submitting this information at the time of filing will help minimize deficiencies and support a more efficient claims review process. Secondary exposure claims other than Mesothelioma claims that are filed without this documentation will have an Ad Hoc Deficiency applied to the claim requesting all the documentation listed above.
